CONTACT YOUR DOCTOR IMMEDIATELY if you experience a change in the amount of urine produced; change or loss in hearing; chest pain; confusion; fainting; fever, chills, or persistent sore throat; mental or mood changes (eg, agitation, anxiety, depression); red, swollen, blistered, or peeling skin; severe or persistent constipation; severe or persistent dizziness, drowsiness, headache, or lightheadedness; shortness of breath; slow, shallow, or difficult breathing; symptoms of liver problems (eg, yellowing of the skin or eyes, pale stools, dark urine, persistent loss of appetite, unusual or severe stomach pain); trouble urinating; unusual bruising or bleeding; unusual tiredness or weakness; or vision changes. AN ALLERGIC REACTION to this medicine is unlikely, but seek immediate medical attention if it occurs. Symptoms of an allergic reaction include rash; hives; itching; difficulty breathing; tightness in the chest; swelling of the mouth, face, lips, throat, or tongue; or unusual hoarseness. If you notice other effects not listed above, contact your doctor, nurse, or pharmacist. This is not a complete list of all side effects that may occur.
